

This course includes the basic principles, criteria and basic principles on which the basic stage curricula are based, and the skills related to the teaching methods of the stage and the competencies required to be acquired by the teachers. It also includes the introduction of various models of teaching methods for this stage and their employment such as: survey, problem solving, brainstorming, Frank Lehmann's strategy. And provide students with strategies for preparing different educational situations and ways of implementing them from planning and formulating educational objectives, classroom management, formulation and employment of classroom questions, promotion and evaluation.
